The CHA of RVA Parks and Beautification Committee Charter

Purpose: The purpose of this committee is to provide support to Church Hill parks and to projects that enhance the beauty of our neighborhood. This may be done by such means as fundraising and logistical or manpower support. The committee should be a point of contact for concerns in these areas as well as a bridge to organizations representing the major greater Church Hill area parks. The committee should maintain a good working relationship with appropriate city agencies and officials.

Committee membership: The committee will have a chairperson appointed by the president of the CHA of RVA. One board member will serve on the committee. Committee members must belong to the CHA of RVA. There should be a minimum of 5 members. Ideally members should represent a cross section of the Church Hill area to ensure a greater familiarity with needs appropriate to this committee.

Meetings: The committee will meet at the call of the chair a minimum of 5 times a year. Meeting times and locations will be determined as needed.

Voting: Committee matters requiring a vote will be resolved by a simple majority of members present. A quorum, designated as one person more than one half of the committee is required for a vote.

Spokesperson: The committee chair is the spokesperson for committee to the board. The president of the CHA of RVA is association's only authorized spokesperson. Only with the president's prior authorization may the chair or any committee member speak on behalf of the association in any formal oral or written obligation.
